(15) Description of equipment:

The heating device ExPolar is used in hazardous locations of zone 1/21 in an ambient temperature range of  $-50^{\circ}\text{C} < T_{\text{amb}} < +60^{\circ}\text{C}$ .

The system consists of heating pad, different encapsulated thermostats and an already certified connection box. The entire device is protected by an enclosure to achieve IP66.
